Updates 20 January-2 February 2026

The Register is maintained by the Parliamentary Commissioner for Standards.

It is updated fortnightly online when Parliament is sitting, and less frequently at other times.

MPs must register all their current financial interests, and any registrable benefits (other than earnings) received in the 12 months before their election within one month of their election, and MPs must register any change in those registrable interests within 28 days.

Interests remain on the Register for 12 months after their date of registration, most recent update or end date, whichever is later.

This document contains only those interests added since the previous version of the Register.

Entries in bold italics indicates interests that have been subject to an investigation by the Parliamentary Commissioner for Standards and subsequently rectified.
